They have not complied with the directions issued by the Committee directing them to seek urgent opinion from the Govt. Pleader and to place it before the Committee. No step appears to have been taken by the Competent Authority to get the opinion of the Govt. Pleader nor the Govt. Pleader has taken any step to record his opinion and place it before the Committee.
- Nobody is present on behalf of Economic Offence Wing (EOW) inspite of notice. The Committee is at pains to point out that looking to the repeated absence of the officers of the Economic Offences Wing and the Competent Authority, the Committee is not in a position to make any progress in the matter with regard to recovery and/or sale of the property.
- Non cooperation on their part is affecting the interest of the investors. In the Circumstances, the Committee is left with no option but to bring these facts to the notice of the Hon'ble High Court to seek appropriate directions against them. Order accordingly.
