- 1. NSEL has prayed for time to produce the document, viz. warehouse agreement. Time is granted till 14.7.2015.
- 2. The learned Counsel appearing for the NSEL has brought to our notice that inspite of notice given to Mr.Ajit Sakhare, Deputy Collector IV, Mumbai to remain present before the Committee in todays hearing, he is not present.
- 3. The learned Counsel brought to our notice an order dated 19.5.2015 passed by the Hon'ble High Court, whereby the Hon'ble High Court has directed disposal of the goods in the matter of Namdhari, for which bids have already been received along with EMDs. In the circumstances, delay in disposal of the goods is causing substantial prejudice to the interest of the bidder as well as the investors.
- 4. In the above circumstances, it is necessary to request the Hon'ble High Court to issue necessary direction to the Competent Authority to take immediate steps to finalise the subject bid.
- 5. A Report to the above effect shall be submitted to the Hon'ble High Court immediately with necessary recommendations
