## ORDER ON APPLICATION OF NSEL INVESTORS ACTION GROUP DATED 30.6.2015. (Dated: 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.)

- 1. The Committee is in receipt of a letter dated 30.6.2015 from the NSEL Investors Action Group requesting to release fund from the NSEL Escrow Account.
- 2. When this application was called out for hearing, the authorized signatory Mr. Ketan Shah is absent. One Mr. Ajay Dalmia, Manager of Investor Action Group is present.
- 3. On being asked, he stated that he does not want to make any more submissions apart from what has already been stated in the Application.
- 4. The Applicant has made a request to the Committee to recommend distribution of funds lying in NSEL Escrow Account (Approx.) of Rs.15 crores without any further delay.
- 5. The amount invested in NSEL Escrow Account as on date cannot be recommended for distribution, in view of the prohibitory order passed by the EOW, New Delhi.
- 6. Mr.Naik, learned Advocate appearing for NSEL informed that NSEL has already moved an application before the Hon'ble Bombay High Court for getting the order passed by EOW, Delhi, vacated. In this view of the matter, unless suitable order is obtained from the Hon'ble High Court, no recommendation for

distribution of funds from the NSEL Escrow Account can be made.

In the result, the Application stands disposed of in terms of this order.
