ORDER SHEET NO. 15C (Dated 14th January, 2015)

- 1. Mr. Vijendra Mishra, Advocate appearing for MSR Foods Processing appeared before the Committee. He prayed for adjournment on the ground that his client Mr. M. Sampat Rao has proceeded to some unknown destination in Kerala for taking Ayurvedic treatment. That he is not aware of his whereabouts.
- 2. EOW has also made a statement that they had gone to the house of Mr. Rao to interrogate him. However, he was not available at home. It is needless to mention that in spite of specific direction to appear before this Committee vide Order Sheet No.14-C dated 22nd December, 2014, Mr. Sampat Rao has been avoiding to appear before this Committee. On the last date of hearing a statement was made by his Advocate that he was bedridden. In support thereof a medical certificate was produced. Today, during the course of hearing a statement is made that he has left for Kerala to take Ayurvedic treatment. It appears he does not want to comply with the directions issued by this Committee.
- 3. EOW has pointed out that his 11 properties are already attached by them and that 4 properties are yet to be attached. Since Mr. Sampat Rao is avoiding to appear before this Committee and chose to appear through his Advocate only to seek adjournment, it is necessary that NSEL to obtain appropriate order for attachment of remaining 4 properties and appointment of the Court Receiver on 11 + 4 properties of Mr. Sampat Rao and to

take steps to get the same disposed off through the Court Receiver of the Hon'ble High Court.

- 4. The Committee, on the above backdrop, recommends to the Hon'be High Court that the aforesaid action needs to be initiated. NSEL may apply to the Hon'ble High Court in Third Party Notice no.5 of 2014 in Suit No.173 of 2014.
